# Sentence in **Cattle Theft and Hindering Secured** Creditor

THANCE JOHNSTON, 31, OF Chillicothe, was sentenced with restitution Feb. 17 after pleading guilty to third degree theft of livestock and 2 counts of hindering



a secured creditor. TSCRA Special Ranger Scott Williamson led the investigation and Wilbarger County District Attorney Staley Heatly prosecuted the case.

Sale records revealed that Johnston had sold 3 calves at the Wichita Falls Livestock Auction in November 2013 that matched the description of 3 calves missing from the ranch where he was employed. The calves were worth a total of \$2,110.80. It was also revealed that Johnston had sold mortgaged property without permission from banks and knowingly gave false information to gain loan proceeds of approximately \$35,000.

Johnston met with Special Ranger Williamson and confessed to stealing the calves, selling mortgaged property and giving false information to banks to gain loan proceeds. Johnston received three 5-year sentences of deferred adjudication and was ordered to pay a total of \$39,634.11 in restitution.

"It is extremely important for cattle ranchers to keep an accurate count on their livestock, practice branding and report suspicious activity to authorities," said Williamson. "If you do not follow these precautions, it makes it difficult for us to recover stolen livestock and return cattle back to the rightful owners."

## Duncan Ranch Rodeo Crowns Champions

The 2015 Duncan Ranch Rodeo was held Friday, Feb. 13 and Saturday, Feb. 14 in Duncan, Okla. Twenty-four teams from Texas, Oklahoma and Missouri competed for cash prizes and merchandise. After the Friday performance, Plus 5 Land and Cattle from Duke, Okla. held a commanding lead in the ranch rodeo.

On Saturday, ranch teams competed hard and by the time the dust settled, Mardis & Wilson, Mangum, Okla., took home the championship. Team members included Matt Mardis, Rodey Wilson, Matt Cramblett and Willie Morris. Cramblett also took home the Top Hand Award and Rodey Wilson took home the Top Horse Award.
