Cattle Raisers Visit Washington D.C. to Talk Trade, Other Issues

TSCRA leaders and staff were in Washington, D.C., April 12 to 14, making visits to Congressional offices to discuss the importance of passing the Trans-Pacific Partnership (TPP) agreement and other issues crucial to the beef industry. The association has been advocating for this agreement to move forward because of the tremendous benefits it will provide for U.S. beef producers by significantly reducing tariffs on beef products.

TSCRA also stressed the need to cut government regulations that are harmful to ranchers.

The group also met with several federal agencies, to talk about animal health issues with USDA-APHIS, private property rights with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM), livestock disaster-assistance programs with USDA's Farm Service Agency (FSA), and more.

TSCRA will continue working with leaders in Washington in order to protect cattlemen and women who provide food for millions of people worldwide.

BOA Tip for May: Color-Coded Syringes for Vaccines



It's common to give more than one vaccine injection when working cattle, but how do you keep up with which syringe you use for which vaccine?

You can label each syringe with different colored tape or use a colored marker to draw a line or dot on each syringe.

Some multi-dose syringes have different colored balls that go on the end of the plunger.
