

# TEXAS WEEKLY SUMMARY

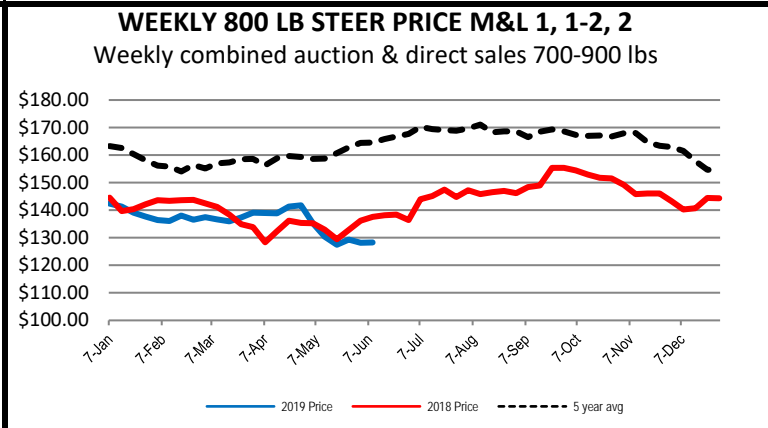
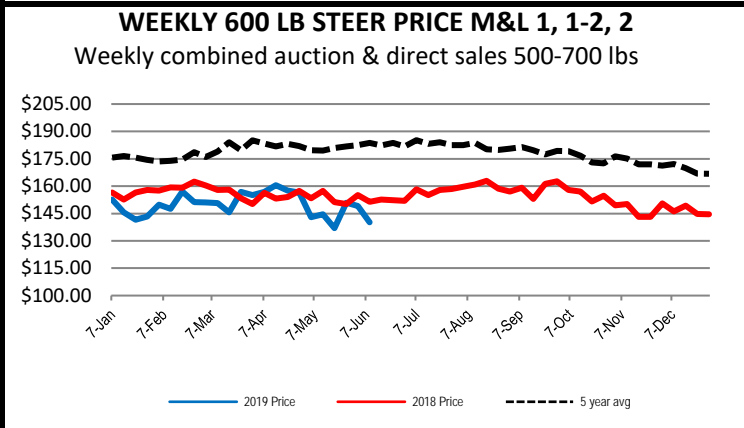
Week Ending June 1, 2019

Receipts: This Week 14,200 Last Week 12,400 Year Ago 19,100

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold steady to 3.00 lower. Trade activity and demand were moderate. Thunderstorms throughout the week dumped several inches of rain and brought damaging winds. Supply included: 34% Feeder Cattle (52% Steers, 44% Heifers, 3% Bulls); 5% Slaughter Cattle (94% Cows, 6% Bulls); 0% Replacement Cattle (68% Stock Cows, 18% Bred Cows, 4% Bred Heifers, 11% Cow-Calf Pairs). Feeder cattle supply over 600 lbs was 81%. Compared to last report: Hay traded steady on light to moderate movement. The whole state has been hampered by rain and baling hay around thunderstorms. All the rain has made hay movement difficult and effected the quality. Pastures are in good conditions so no supplemental feeding needed for livestock out on grass. Coastal Bermuda producers in the east have rye in some of their coastal due to delayed cutting and not being able to spay because of rain.
