Receipts: This Week 29,100 Last Week 25,000 Year Ago 20,100

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold 1.00 to 5.00 higher. Trade activity and demand were moderate to good. The momentum continued this week as the cattle markets continued to regain the big losses from two weeks ago. Slaughter cows and bulls sold 1.00-3.00 lower. Hay trades were mostly steady. Hay demand has recovered this week as volatility in the feeder cattle markets have begun to stabilize. Producers are beginning to supplement livestock as range conditions continue to decline in the West, Central, and South regions due to extreme heat and lack of moisture. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly mostly 2 to 3 cents lower on grain sorghum; 5 to 9 cents lower on wheat; mostly 1 to 2 cents lower on corn.

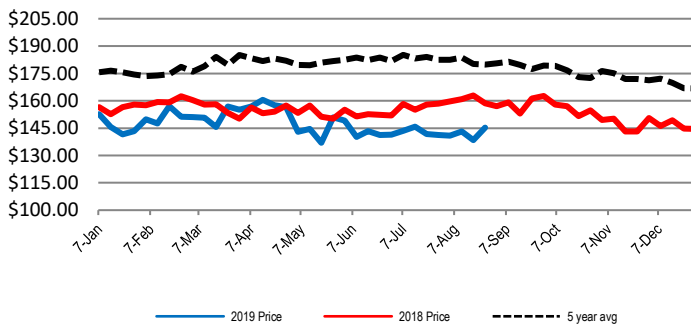

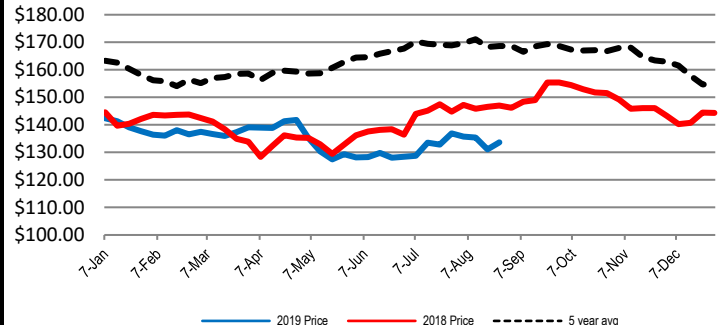
