

# TEXAS WEEKLY SUMMARY

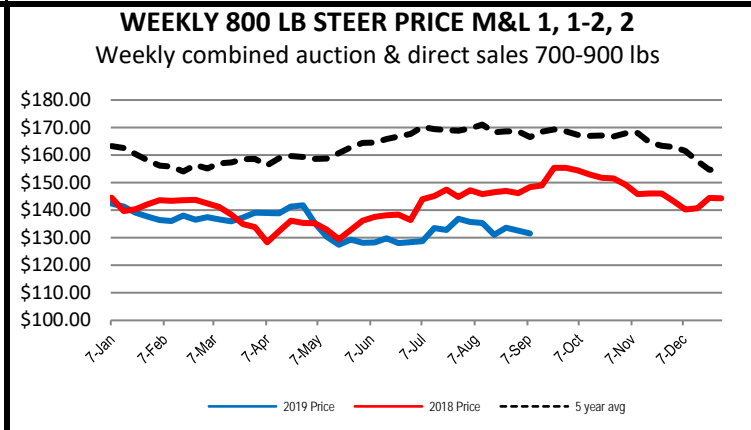
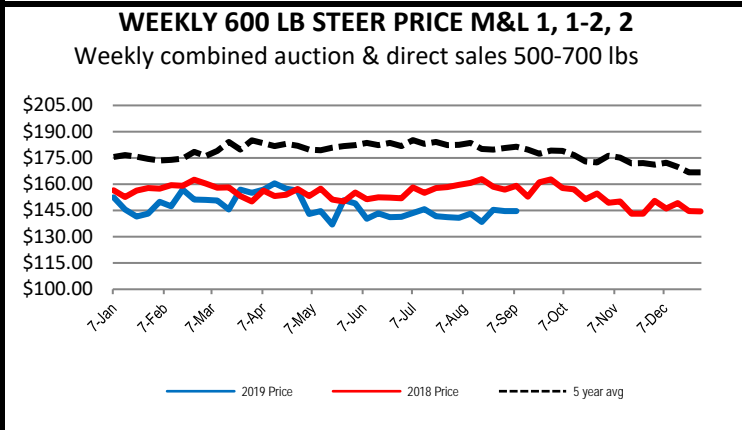
Week Ending **September 21, 2019**

Receipts: This Week 38,000 Last Week 39,000 Year Ago 44,800

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold 1.00 to 5.00 higher. Trade was moderate on good demand. Heavy rainfall to end the week was a welcomed sight as most producers have planted their winter wheat crops. Fleshy slaughter cows 1.00 higher; lean slaughter cows and bulls 1.00 to 2.00 lower. Most hay trades were steady with instances of Alfalfa 5.00 lower. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly 3 to 4 cents lower on grain sorghum; mostly 2 to 2 cents lower on wheat; mostly 1 to 2 cents lower on corn. Most elevators have rolled to the Dec bids.
