BQA Tip: Be Aware of Herbicide and Pesticide Restrictions

Herbicides and insecticides are applied to pastures to control weeds and insects. When using these pesticides, it is important to read and follow label directions for grazing and having restrictions. Additionally, only products that are labeled for use in



pastures and hayfields should be used. Labels for many of these pesticides can be found at cdms.net/label-database.

Reward Offered for Information on Saddle Stolen in Wichita Falls

TSCRA Special Ranger John Bradshaw, Dist. 9 in North Central Texas, and local law enforcement authorities are seeking information on a saddle stolen in Wichita Falls on Sept. 14. The saddle is a Bob Marrs roping saddle on a Buster Welch tree, with a 16-1/2 inch rough-out seat and skirt and swells tooled with a floral pattern. There is a steer on each corner of the skirt and the stirrups are aluminum.

The victims are offering a \$2,000 reward for information leading to the location and recovery of the saddle. In addition, they are also offering a separate \$2,500 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of a suspect or suspects involved in the theft.
