Fort Worth Stock Show Passes

It's an annual fall tradition — the November rush of TSCRA members reserving their Stock Show grounds passes. The Fort Worth Stock Show and Rodeo offers TSCRA members free grounds admission for the full run of the 2019 Fort Worth Stock Show and Rodeo. Each membership is eligible to receive two grounds passes. All you do is visit tscra.org/fwssr or send in the form found in the November issue of *The Cattleman* magazine.

When you order, you will receive two 1-day passes from the Fort Worth Stock Show and Rodeo. This pass will get you onto the grounds and can be redeemed in the International Suite located in the Richardson-Bass Building for a TSCRA commemorative pin. Commemorative pins are only available through this program. The deadline to request these passes is Dec. 31.
