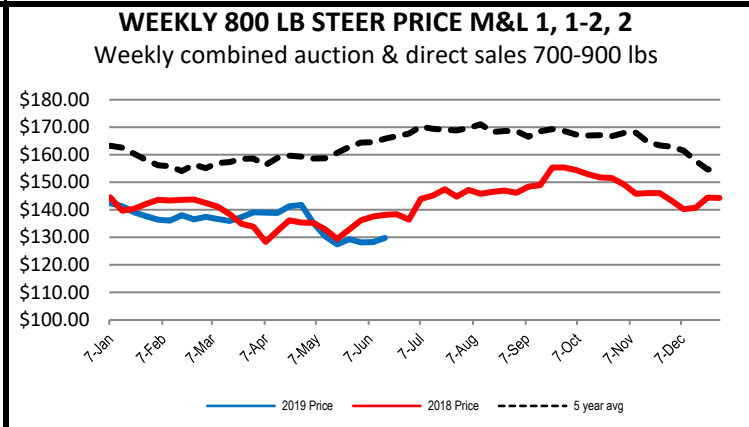
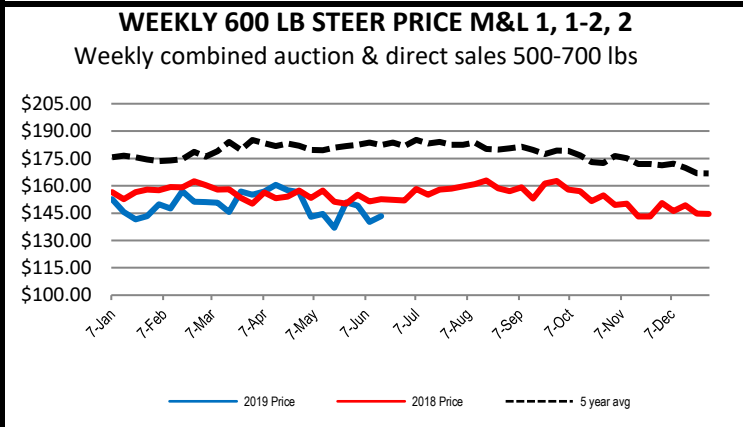
Week Ending June 15, 2019

Receipts: This Week 32,100 Last Week 14,200 Year Ago 29,700

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold steady to instance 3.00 lower. Trade activity and demand were moderate to good. Sunshine and mildly warm temperatures gave the area a chance to dry out and producers were able to get their cattle to market. Slaughter cows sold 1.00 higher. Hay traded steady to marginally lower on light to moderate movement. Rain across the state has continued to make hay movement difficult and effected quality in some regions. Portions of East Texas have been granted a small break from the rain which has allowed farmers in these areas to begin bailing. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly 12 to 21 cents higher on grain sorghum; 4 to 8 cents higher on wheat; mostly 7 to 11 cents higher on corn.
