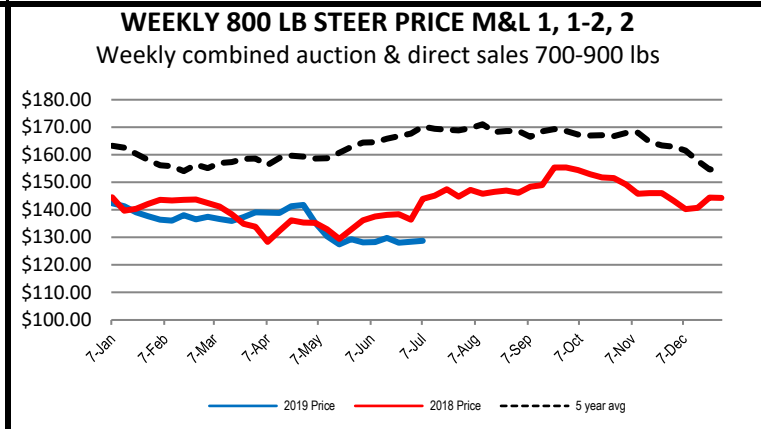
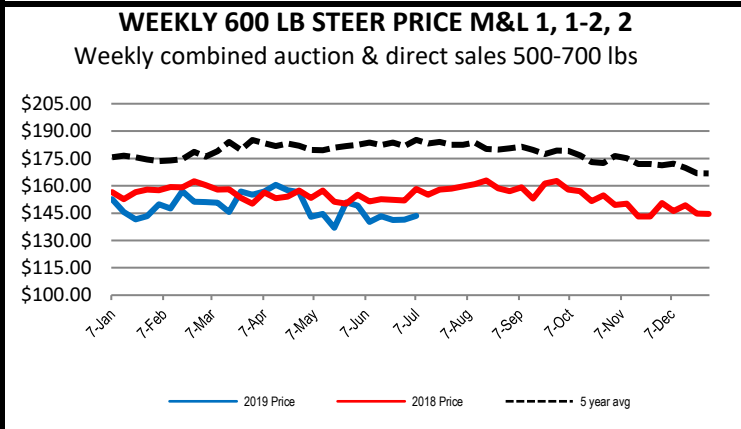
Week Ending July 6, 2019

Receipts: This Week 18,900 Last Week 19,900 Year Ago 11,700

Compared to last week: Current FOB sales of steers and heifers sold steady to 3.00 higher on light comparable sales. Trade activity and demand were moderate on a shortened holiday week. Slaughter cows and bulls not tested this week. Hay prices from a week ago - no report the week of the 4th. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly 3 to 9 cents higher on grain sorghum; mostly 1 to 6 cents higher on wheat; mostly 2 to 7 cents higher on corn. Some elevators have rolled to the Sept bids.
