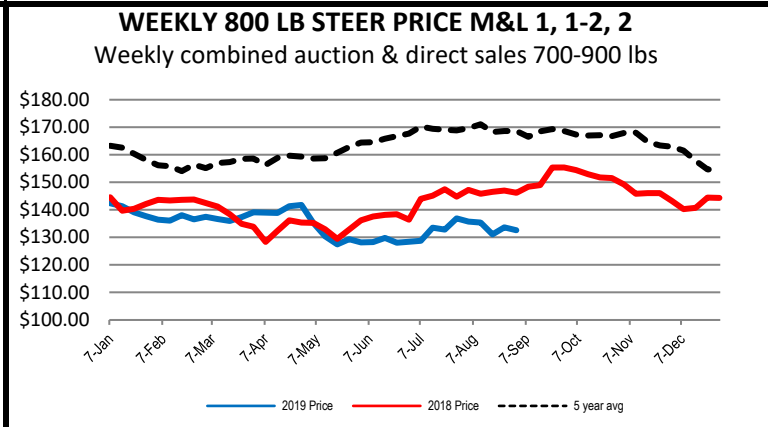
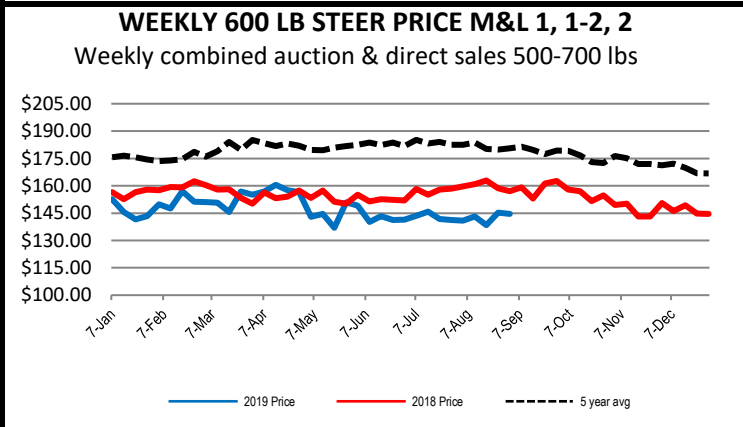
Week Ending **September 7, 2019**

Receipts: This Week 25,500 Last Week 29,100 Year Ago 26,600

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold mostly steady. Trade activity was light to moderate on moderate demand for a shortened week due to Labor Day. Slaughter cows and bulls sold 1.00-3.00 lower. Hay trades were mostly steady. Trading activity and hay demand remain good, as producers are beginning to supplement livestock. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly mostly 1 to 6 cents lower on grain sorghum; unchanged to 5 cents lower on wheat; mostly 2 to 4 cents lower on corn. Most elevators have rolled to the Dec bids.
