

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Receipts: This Week 39,000 Last Week 25,500 Year Ago 31,500

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold unevenly steady depending when in the week cattle sold. Sales in the beginning of the week were steady to 3.00 lower; however, by the end of the week the market picked back up and sold steady to 3.00 higher. Slaughter cows and bulls sold 1.00-5.00 lower. Hay trades were mostly steady to firm. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly 2 to 3 cents higher on grain sorghum; 3 to 4 cents lower on wheat; mostly 1 to 2 cents higher on corn. Most elevators have rolled to the Dec bids.



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
