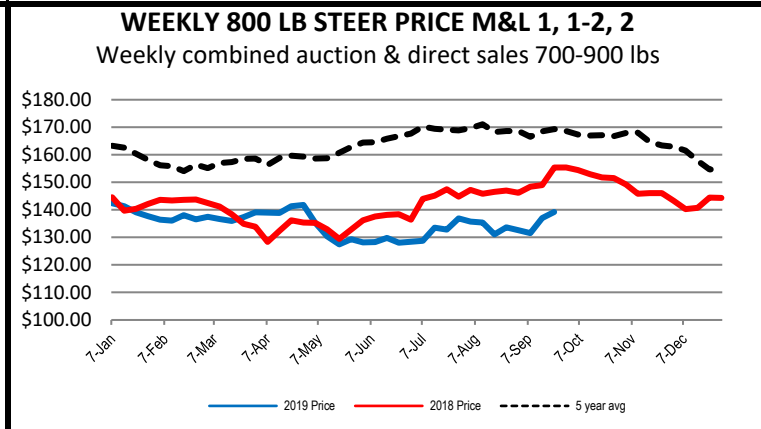
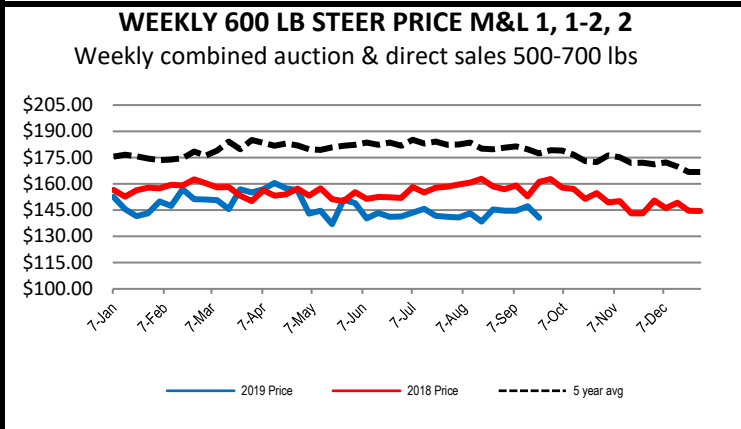
Week Ending **September 28, 2019**

Receipts: This Week 39,200 Last Week 38,000 Year Ago 23,100

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers sold steady to as much as 5.00 higher. Trade was moderate on good demand. Slaughter cows and bulls steady to weak. All hay classes traded mostly steady. Trade activity was moderate to good with a large variety on the market this time of year. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were mostly 1 to 2 cents lower on grain sorghum; mostly 1 to 6 cents lower on wheat; mostly 1 to 2 cents lower on corn. Most elevators have rolled to the Dec bids.
