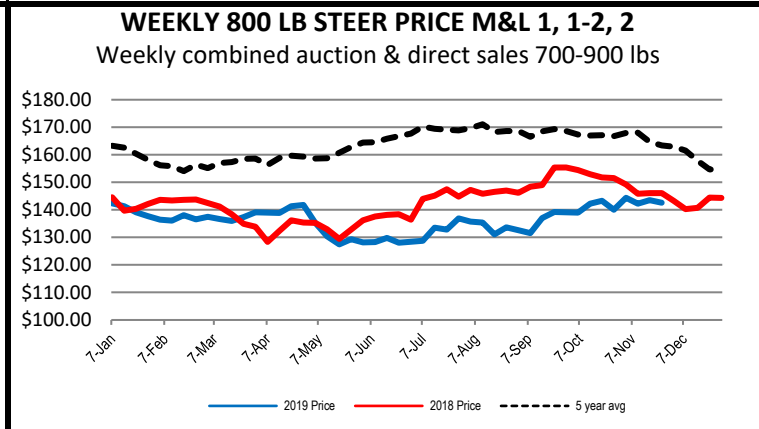
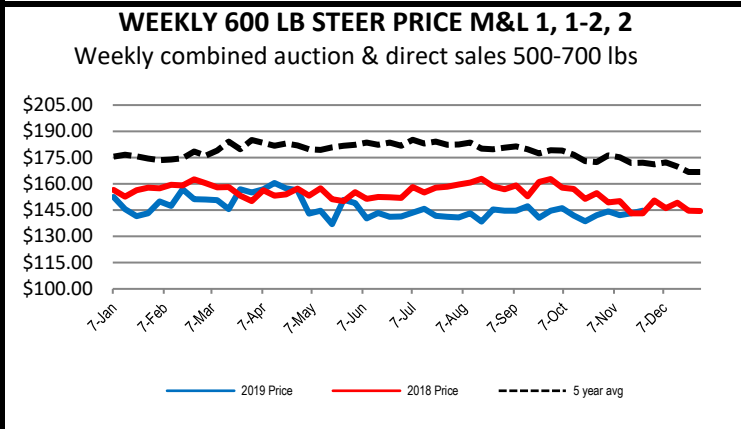
Week Ending **November 23, 2019**

Receipts: This Week 24,600 Last Week 27,800 Year Ago 10,800

Compared to last week: Steer and heifer calves steady to 6.00 lower. Few yearling cattle sold mostly steady. Demand moderate for calves as a cold front moved thru bringing cold temps and rain. Slaughter cows and bulls steady. Trade fairly active. Demand fairly good. Hay trades were steady on good demand and moderate to active trading activity. Hay demand is continuing to pickup as feeding demand picks up. In the Texas High Plains grain markets the bulk of bids were unchanged to 1 cent higher on grain sorghum; 3 to 4 cents higher on wheat; unchanged on corn.
