



Young Cattlemen's Conference Application Instructions

Purpose: To develop leadership qualities in young cattle raisers and expose them to all aspects of the beef industry. The tour and conference helps young leaders understand all areas of the beef business.

Qualifications:

- Active member in good standing of the Texas and Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association
- Active member of the National Cattleman's Beef Association
- 25-50 years of age

Duties:

- Commit to serving in a leadership position with the TSCRA Young Leadership Series for two years
- Assist staff in recruiting future YLS and YCC participants
- Serve as spokesperson for YLS, if needed
- Submit written report on the conference to TSCRA staff for distribution to TSCRA board of directors
- Oral presentation on experience to TSCRA Membership Development Committee
- Provide tour photos to *The Cattleman* magazine. The participant may supply their own photos or may direct NCBA to provide photos and a news release to the magazine no less than 30 days post trip

Award (TSCRA to cover following costs):

- Registration costs for 2023 NCBA Young Cattlemen's Conference held in May/June 2023
- Reasonable coach-class airfare from the participant's home to Denver and from Washington D.C. to the participant's home
- Incidental and meal expenses not covered by the registration fees are the responsibility of the participant

Interviews:

- The selection committee will screen YCC applications and choose applicants for in person interviews
- In person interviews will be conducted on Thursday, March 24 during the 2022 Cattle Raisers Convention & Expo in Fort Worth, Texas
