National Cattlemen's Beef Association's Young Cattlemen's Conference 2025 Application Instructions

Purpose: To develop leadership qualities in young producers and professionals and expose them to all aspects of the beef industry. The tour and conference helps leaders understand all areas of the beef value chain.

Qualifications:

- Active member in good standing of the Texas & Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association.
- Active member of the National Cattlemen's Beef Association.
- 25-50 years of age.

Duties:

- Assist in recruiting future young producer and professionals to apply through grassroots encouragement.
- Serve as spokesperson for TSCRA, if needed.
- Submit written report or highlights on the conference to TSCRA staff for distribution through *The Cattleman*
- Provide tour photos to *The Cattleman* magazine. The participant may supply their own photos or may direct NCBA to provide photos and a news release to the magazine no less than 30 days post trip.

Interviews:

- The selection committee will screen YCC applications and choose applicants for in-person interviews.
- In-person interviews will be conducted during the TSCRA Young Producers Event held September 21, 2024 in Boerne, Texas.

Application Instructions:

- Complete and sign the application.
- Enclose two letters of recommendation.
- Return to education@tscra.org by August 1, 2024.

Texas & Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association will select up to three applicants to attend the NCBA Young Cattlemen's Conference in summer of 2025. TSCRA will cover the registration costs for attendees to attend the event and airfare to and from the conference.
