

# TSCRA Leadership Development Foundation Working Grant Program Application

The TSCRA Leadership Development Foundation Working Grant Program helps provide needed cash capital to individuals or operations who are building a long-term career in the beef industry.

The program provides grants to help ranchers and beef producers start, run or grow their operation. Grants can be used for expenses that make it hard to move your business forward - like buying equipment, making land improvements, building new facilities, purchasing livestock or other similar needs.

To be eligible for a grant, an applicant must:

- 1. Operate its beef business in an economically depressed or blighted area in Texas or Oklahoma;
- 2. Be disadvantaged (e.g. minority, unemployed or underemployed);
- 3. Own and operate a beef business that has experienced difficulty in obtaining convention financing because of its existence in a deteriorated neighborhood or because of his/her disadvantaged status;
- 4. Not be an employee, officer or member of the board of directors of the Texas & Southwestern Cattle Raisers Association or a parent, spouse, child or grandchild of any such person.

An applicant must answer all questions in the grant application carefully. If an applicant fails to meet one of the eligibility requirements (or fails to adequately explain in its responses to the grant application how it satisfies the eligibility requirements), the grant application will be rejected.

The fact that an applicant may meet all of the eligibility requirements shall not give the applicant an automatic right to be awarded a grant from the TSCRA Leadership Development Foundation (LDF). The TSCRA LDF, in addition to rejecting applications, reserves the right to either fully or partially fund applications.

### **Application Type:**

The TSCRA LDF Working Grant Program now includes three distinct funding categories: cattle, land improvement and equipment.

Applicants should select **one category per application** and provide information specific to that category. Multiple applications may be submitted within the same period; however, each application's financials and information must correspond to the selected category. This ensures a fair and consistent review process.

Cattle: to be used for the purchase or down payment of purchase of livestock				
Equipment: to be used for purchase of beef operation equipment such as chutes, feed troughs, hay rings, used tractors, used tractor attachments, trailers, direct-to-consumer beef supplies, ultrasound machines, or other				
Land improvement: to be used for brush clean up or control, fertilizer, grass sprigs, water well installation or supplies, soil or well tests, electrical, road installment, barns, fencing, gates, or other (land purchases will not be funded, unless said land purchase is a buy out of family shares and/or leases)

**Describe how you have experienced difficulty in obtaining conventional financing**: offer insight into how you have experienced difficulty in obtaining conventional financing and/or share how a TSCRA LDF Working Grant Program grant would assist you in obtaining conventional financing. (max. 500 words)

What are the significant challenges preventing you from reaching the goals of your operation? (max. 500 words)

How will this grant help you overcome the challenges as listed? (max. 500 words)

What's your personal time investment into the beef operation? (max. 250 words)

What's your personal financial investment into the beef operation? (max. 250 words)

How will you be able to define the successful use of the grant? And/or how do you plan to measure the success of your goals? (max. 500 words)
